

### This Issues Recipe **Tomato & Potato Soup**

Serves: 2

Prep time: 5 minutes Cook time: 35 minutes Ready in: 40 minutes



### **Main Ingredients:**

Tomatoes: 4 medium Vegetable Stock: 1 cup

Potatoes: 1 small, peeled and shredded

Basil Leaves: 10 Cream: 2 tbsp

Salt: 1/8 tsp (or according to your taste or limit) Black Pepper: 1/8 tsp (or according to your taste)

Boil water in a medium size saucepan. Reduce the heat and put the tomatoes in the

water for 2-3 minutes.

Drain the water and let the tomatoes cool slightly. Skin and then puree the tomatoes. Place the tomato puree and vegetable stock in a medium size saucepan over medium heat. Simmer for 20 minutes.

Add the potato (shredded) to the tomato mixture

and simmer for 10 more minutes.
Finely chop 8 basil leaves and add them to the tomato mixture

Stir in the heavy cream and season with salt and pepper. Let heat for few more minutes. Do not boil.

Pour the soup in serving bowls. Decorate the bowls with the remaining basil leaves and serve

### **Seniors Assistance**

The OPP has established a Seniors Assistance Team. Listed below are a few examples of the types of scams the OPP want seniors to be aware of and how to avoid them.

**Telephone Scams** - Con artists prey on the fact that seniors are too nice for their own good and are hesitant to say no. Remember, if something sounds too good to be true, then it probably is.

Home Improvement Scams - Beware of persons showing up unannounced at your door requesting your business with regards to home improvements. They may not be legitimate and won't deliver what they promised.

Bank Cards and ATM's - As we age, there is a need to sometimes rely on others for assistance. A current trend has the senior handing out his/her bank card and PIN # (Personal Identification Number). Assure you can rely on a person before handing over your PIN #.

Home Safety - People tend to feel more secure in their own homes. It's important to take a few extra minutes to make sure you are as safe as possible. Always keep your doors and windows locked; even when at home. Install a peephole. Ask for proper identification from deliverymen or strangers don't feel intimidated into opening your door. If a stranger shows up at your door looking to use your phone - talk to them through your locked door and offer to place the call for them.
